DRESS REHEARSAL INFORMATION: Thursday, June 6 (see schedule below)

Dancers should arrive at the **Prairie Center** at least 15 minutes before their 'stage-call' time, **dressed with hair and make-up done, and ready to dance**. You and your dancer may report to the theatre and wait to be called on stage. The instructors will not be able to wait for late arrivals because we need to stay on schedule. With dancers this age, we recommend lipstick and blush and brown or plum colored eye shadow. Stage make up is worn so the dancer's face and smile will not be washed out under the bright stage lights. Just as swimmers do not wear underwear under their swimsuits, dancers do not wear underwear under their costumes. Wearing both tights and a costume guarantee dancers have plenty of coverage. If your child has a costume change, you must purchase a nude camisole leotard (\$15.00, available for purchase at the studio while supplies last) for them to wear under their costume at all times. This will allow them to change their costume and always be fully clothed. A limited supply of pink and nude tights (\$10) is also available for purchase at the studio. Please remember to label all of your child's belongings.

Please arrive to rehearsal by the arrival time listed below so your dancer will be ready to take the stage at her/his stage call time. You need only be present at the theatre for your child's specified rehearsal time, however you are welcome to stay and watch the other dances. Since we have hired a professional videographer to record the recital, recording the actual show is not allowed, however you are welcome to record the dress rehearsal.

At dress rehearsal, you will be shown the location of the holding area or dressing room they will use during the **June 8** show.

PERFORMANCE INFORMATION:

Please arrive 30 minutes before the start of the show and bring your dancer dressed and ready, to the backstage dressing area. Instructors and older student helpers will be with the dancers during the performance. **Dancers must remain backstage throughout the entire recital.** The show should last no more than 45 minutes. Please remain in your seat for the duration of the show. Every child has worked hard this year and deserves a respectful audience. In order to keep crowd control manageable, when the show is over please designate one person to go backstage to pick up your child. Your dancer can then be brought out to meet her/his eagerly awaiting fans.

Our recitals will be professionally recorded so videotaping during the performance will not be allowed. It is discourteous to surrounding audience members to record your child on your phone during the show. All recording should be done at dress rehearsal.

For the safety of the dancer, flash photography is not allowed during the performance.

We hope to see your dancer in class this summer! Our 5 week summer session begins the week of June 24 and ends July 27. **Please register your child for the same level class they are enrolled in now.** Our new dance year does not begin until September and registration and level placements will be mailed out at the end of July. Summer class information can be found on our website.

Rise dance classes A through J will have three shows performing at the Prairie Center on Friday, June 7 at 7:00 and Saturday, June 8 at 1:00 and 6:00. We hope you and your dancer can attend one of these shows. The 'big kids' perform and they are truly spectacular! If your dancer is a second grader and plans on continuing her dance education, this is the show she/he will be performing in next year. Dancers going into third grade are also eligible to audition for **Shine Performance**, one of the studio's dance companies. Auditions are on Friday, June 28, 5:30 at Rise.
